Collected at a waste collection point	Burnables Ibara City designated rubbish bag	Kitchen waste, Rubber/leather, Garden waste, Diapers, Video tapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Kitchen waste must be dried out before disposal · Diapers must be washed before disposal · Secure cassettes and video tapes with packing tape · Rubbish must be less than 30cm big 	Every week	
	Non-burnables Ibara City designated rubbish bag	Metal, Toys, Crockery, Glass, Plastic buckets, washing tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Empty containers before disposal (especially lighters) · Broken glass must be wrapped in thick paper and labeled accordingly · The bone part of an umbrella is non-burnable rubbish · Rubbish must be less than 30cm big 	Every month	
	Recyclables	Cans/Bottles Transparent rubbish bag	Cans, Glass bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Containers must be emptied, washed, and drained · Lids and caps must be removed · Pierce a hole in aerosol cans before disposal · Cosmetic and oil bottles are non-burnable rubbish 	Every month
		PET Bottles Transparent rubbish bag	PET, Drinking bottles, Oil bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Bottles must be emptied, washed, and drained · Lids and caps must be removed, and disposed of in "plastic containers and packaging" 	
		Plastic containers and packaging Transparent rubbish bag	Food containers, Polystyrene foam, Containers and packaging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Containers must be emptied, washed, and drained · Lids and caps must be removed 	
	Not collected at a waste collection point	Waste paper and clothing	Newspapers, Magazines, Cardboard boxes, Milk cartons, Other paper waste, Old clothes, Waste cooking oil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Flatten out and bundle up the cardboard with string, so it can be held with one hand · Put waste cooking oil in a bottle and tighten the cap 	2 nd Saturday of every month
		Oversized/Landfill rubbish	Furniture, Bedding, Tatami, Carpet, Bicycles, Home appliances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Take burnables to Ibara Clean Centre · Take non-burnables to Ikasa Resource Centre, or Ibara Recycling Centre, with permission from the city · Flatten furniture into a plank-like shape so it's not more than 5cm thick, and 2m long · Take landfill rubbish to Nonosako Disposal site, with permission from the city 	
		Rubbish not dealt with by the city	Tires, Motorcycles, Dangerous materials, AC, TV, washing machine, refrigerator, Farm equipment, pesticide, chemical bottles, solar water heaters, gas cylinders, etc	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Consult a dealer or disposal company

- Littering is prohibited by the city.
- Burnables, non-burnables, and recyclables are also collected on bank holidays.
- Please note that rubbish disposed of which is not in compliance with these rules will not be collected.
